Sponsor-A-Classroom: Spring 2020 Winner



What is aquaponics? It's a system of aquaculture in which the waste produced by farmed fish or other aquatic animals supplies nutrients for plants grown hydroponically, which in turn purifies the water.

The second grade students will study a natural ecosystem and learn about the relationship between water, aquatic life, bacteria, nutrients, and plants.

The ultimate goal of the project is to effectively grow vegetables and provide healthy snacks to students in need. We are proud to support this inspiring initiative!






Did You Know?


