

Washington Area Federal Credit Union Scholarship

Three scholarships of \$1,000 each will be awarded.

This scholarship is available to graduating high school seniors who plan to pursue post-secondary education in the Fall of 2023.

Requirements:

- Applicant must attend high school at one of the districts within the credit union's field of membership.
- Applicant must provide high school transcript and maintain a 2.5 or higher cumulative GPA.
- Applicant must submit a letter of acceptance to a post-secondary college, university or career school.
- Applicant must submit one (1) letter of recommendation. (Non-Relative)
- Applicant must complete attached application. If more room is needed, please attach a separate sheet.
- Applicant must submit a 500-750-word essay that answers the question, "What past experiences have influenced your decision to pursue post-secondary education?"

Applications must be received no later than April 7, 2023.

Scholarships will be awarded to students who display academic achievement, exemplary character and leadership, and provide service to the community.
