# 2023: A Year in Review

The 64<sup>th</sup> year of operation brought both challenges and opportunities to the Credit Union. Changes within the economy, personal finances, and the interest rate environment led to a unique landscape of loan and share demand. The organization continued to adjust to new norms while the market moved and member needs shifted. By year end, the Credit Union was able to strengthen its position; increasing capital and loan balances, and stabilizing share deposit growth.

2023 was a strong year for the Credit Union. Financial stability was strengthened by the success of our investment and lending portfolios along with the diligent management of costs and expenses throughout the year.

- · New relationships established: 235 new member accounts
- $\cdot$  ROA of 2.31% / Net Income of \$ 1,743,215.43 booked
- $\cdot$  Dividends paid out to the membership in 2023: \$136,871
- · 6.5% Annual Loan Growth: \$7,122,520.46 in loans lent out to our membership
- · Delinquency and loan loss levels remain low at 0.36%

Looking ahead, the landscape will continue to transform. Shifting interest rate environments, proposed regulatory changes, inflation, heightened fraud, and increasing competition are all new hurdles to face. As your trusted resource and financial partner, we are committed to evolving to meet your needs throughout all of life's transformations.

In 2024, the Credit Union will make enhancements to checking account products and the mobile app. We will also introduce new loan options into the home equity product suite. Planned upgrades to investment service platforms will occur. Additional debt management resources and e-Sign conveniences will also be added. Efforts to increase member awareness and protection in high concern areas including fraud prevention, elder abuse, financial hardship, and estate planning will be ongoing.

Did you know that you can access Credit Card activity quickly and conveniently via online or mobile banking? Did you know that you can temporarily deactivate your Debit Card via online or mobile banking? Here are some tips to help you manage your cards.

**Monitor Your Credit Card Activity:** Simply login to online or mobile banking, display the menu options, and select eZCard. Choose your credit card and e-mail address from the dropdown lists, and click submit. When the eZCard page

displays, you can conveniently view your card balance, payment information, posted transactions, and pending authorizations. You can also establish activity alerts to help you monitor real-time activity. If you don't recognize a purchase, contact the Credit Union right away. Outside of Credit Union business hours, report unauthorized activity or lost/stolen cards to credit cardholder support at 800-991-4961.

**Debit Card Remote Control:** If you suspect unauthorized debit card purchases, or if your card is lost or stolen, you can immediately deactivate it via electronic banking channels. To remotely control your debit card, login to online or mobile banking, choose Remote Control Cards from the menu, select your Debit Card, and click on the applicable status option. If you locate your missing card or confirm questionable charges, simply reactivate the card for immediate use. If you feel your card has been compromised, please call the Credit Union immediately after deactivating. Outside of Credit Union business hours, report unauthorized activity or lost/stolen cards to debit cardholder support at 800-991-4965.
